

The Mayor and Council of the City of Franklin met in a Public Hearing on Tuesday, March 19, 2024, 5:45 p.m. at City Hall, 300 Iberia Street, Franklin, Louisiana. Mayor Eugene Foulcard called the meeting to order. Also present were Councilmembers Chuck Autin, Lester Levine, Jaime Robison and City Clerk Karen LeBlanc. Absent were Councilmembers Joseph Garrison and Larry Guilbeau.

The invocation was offered by Mayor Foulcard and Councilman Robison led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Clerk Karen LeBlanc read aloud the hearing Call and stated that the purpose of the hearing was to hear public comments on:

Ordinance No. 3448 – An Ordinance amending the Operating Budget of Revenues and Expenditures for the Fiscal Year beginning May First (1st), 2023 and ending April Thirtieth (30th), 2024.

Ordinance No. 3449 – An Ordinance amending the Capital Outlay Budget of Revenues and Expenditures for the Fiscal Year beginning May First (1st), 2023 and ending April Thirtieth (30th), 2024.

Ordinance No. 3450 – An Ordinance adopting the Operating Budget of Revenues and Expenditures for the Fiscal Year beginning May First (1st), 2024 and ending April Thirtieth (30th), 2025.

Ordinance No. 3451 – An Ordinance adopting the Capital Outlay Budget for the Fiscal Years beginning May First (1st), 2024 and ending April Thirtieth (30th), 2029.

Mrs. LeBlanc read the titles aloud and asked if there were any comments to be made.

No public comment heard.

A motion to adjourn made by Councilman Levine. Second by Councilman Robison and carried.
