General Information

- All building contractors without a state license or a home improvement contractor that are not state registered are not allowed to do any residential work over \$7,500 or Commercial work over \$50,000.
- State registered home improvement contractors are allowed to do residential work not in excess of \$75,000. Please note this amount shall include all labor and materials.
- State registered home improvement contractors and state licensed contractors are required to show certificates evidencing workers compensation in compliance with Title 23 of the Louisiana Statutes of 1950 and general liability insurance in a minimum amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).
- All required documents must be submitted and application completed and approved prior to issuance of permit.

Sec. 14-8. - Certificate of registration; requirement.

No person shall engage in business in the city as any of the following, or work in any of the following occupations or trades in the city, without a certificate of registration issued by the city:

- (1) Electrical;
- (2) Plumbing;
- (3) Mechanical/heating, ventilation, air conditioning (HVAC)

Sec. 14-9. - Examination.

No person shall be issued a certificate of registration under this division [article] for any of the following categories until the person has provided the city with the following items when required by the state: a valid state license, a valid occupational license and a current certificate of insurance, all for the trade in which he is requesting the certificate of registration.

- (1) Master electrician;
- (2) Mechanical contractor/heating, ventilation, air conditioning (HVAC);
- (3) Master Plumber;
- (4) Journeyman plumber.

Sec. 14-10. - Fees.

No person shall be issued a certificate of registration under this chapter, until he pays to the city a fee in the amount hereby established:

- (1) Any applicant or business domiciled within the corporate limits of the city shall be assessed an annual fee of \$100.00 per year. If an application is made on or after July 1 of any calendar year, then the fee payable for that calendar year shall be \$50.00.
- (2) Any applicant or business domiciled outside the corporate limits of the city shall be assessed an annual fee of \$200.00 per year. If an application is made on or after July 1 of any calendar year, then the fee payable for that calendar year shall be \$100.00.

Sec. 14-11. - Expiration; renewal.

Certificates of registration issued expire on December 31 of the calendar year for which issued.
