The Mayor and Council of the City of Franklin met in Regular Session on Tuesday, July 20, 2021, at 6:00 PM at City Hall, 300 Iberia Street, Franklin, Louisiana. Mayor Eugene P. Foulcard called the meeting to order. Also present were Councilmembers Chuck Autin, Larry Guilbeau, Lester Levine, Jaime Robison, City Attorney Russell J. Cremaldi, and City Clerk Karen LeBlanc. Mr. Darrell Bennet and Mrs. Penny Bennet, 210 Wall Street, were present to express displeasure with AmeriPure Oyster Company and the living conditions on Wall Street due to the facility's conditions. They stated that they have spoken to many attorneys and the attorneys always send him back to the city council.

Mayor Foulcard stated that Mr. and Mrs. Bennet had previously filed a lawsuit with the Department of Justice which was kicked out. The DOJ forwarded the claim to the Department of Environmental Quality said that there was no basis on their claims. The city no longer has anything to do with AmeriPure. He encouraged Mr. and Mrs. Bennet to hire an attorney.

MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE REPORT:

Mayor Foulcard announced that the City of Franklin has been awarded a \$1 million grant through the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant program for the HVAC systems at the recreation centers. Both recreation centers will be receiving new HVAC systems.
