

The Mayor and Council of the City of Franklin met in a Public Hearing on Tuesday, March 16, 2021, 5:45 p.m. at City Hall, 300 Iberia Street, Franklin, Louisiana. Mayor Eugene Foulcard called the meeting to order. Also present were Councilmembers Chuck Autin, Joseph Garrison, Larry Guilbeau, Lester Levine, Jaime Robison, City Attorney Russel Cremaldi, and City Clerk Karen LeBlanc.

The invocation was offered by Mayor Foulcard and Councilman Robison led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The purpose of the hearing was to hear public comments on:

Ordinance #3411 – An Ordinance amending the Operating Budget of Revenues and Expenditures for the Fiscal Year beginning May First (1st), 2020 and ending April Thirtieth (30th), 2021.

Ordinance #3412 – An Ordinance amending the Capital Outlay Budget of Revenues and Expenditures for the Fiscal Year beginning May First (1st), 2020 and ending April Thirtieth (30th), 2021.

Ordinance #3413 – An Ordinance adopting the Operating Budget of Revenues and Expenditures for the Fiscal Year beginning May First (1st), 2021 and ending April Thirtieth (30th), 2022.

Ordinance #3414 – An Ordinance adopting the Capital Outlay Budget for the Fiscal Years beginning May First (1st), 2021 and ending April Thirtieth (30th), 2026.

City Clerk Karen LeBlanc read the titles aloud and asked if there were any comments to be made. No public comment heard.

A motion to adjourn made by Councilman Autin. Second by Councilman Robison and carried.
